

Kindergarten Wednesday Enrichment Program Block Classes

Welcome to a fun and exciting program for kindergarten students!

Come join the Forest Charter Kindergarten enrichment program every **Wednesday from 9:00-1:30**. Students will make friends as they learn to share, listen and take turns while enjoying kindergarten sized chairs and tables and an outside attached playground. Lessons will include topics such as community helpers, animals, and geography, all taught through stories, art, games, science activities and discussions. Talk to your Forest Charter Supervising Teacher (ST) to enroll your kindergarten student today!

The K day **(9:00-1:30)** will begin with greetings, simple songs, calendar and sharing time. Students will also learn and rotate a variety of classroom jobs (such as taking attendance, monitoring the coat rack, and maintaining the classroom.) This part of the day builds community and helps children learn important concepts in math and oral language arts. In addition, children will have stretching and outside fitness and games in the playground next to the building. The K class will explore science, social studies, math, phonics activities, writing, art, music, drama and more in the K program. The order of activities will partly depend on the day's projects.

At **1:30** the K students may go home or may join the **K-2** last class of the day.

**K students will eat lunch from 12:00-12:30 with all the other students (1st-8th). The teacher will lead them to the lunch area and will go meet them after lunch to lead them back to class.

This is an enrichment program and is not intended to teach phonics or writing or math in a directed way. Through stories and activities students will learn a lot in many subjects, but this enrichment program **does not replace phonics, writing and math lessons that should be taught at home.
