Provide one-time funding (SB 828) with the intent to provide high school pupils, specifically unduplicated pupils, with additional supports to increase the number of students who enroll at institutions of higher education and complete an undergraduate degree within four years. The grant funds are available for expenditure or encumbrance through the 2018-2019 fiscal year and must align with the schools Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP).
