# Class-Artists in Action Grades 1/2 Lesson-Line Art Teacher-Kaleen Chatigny

The purpose of this lesson to teach students about the artist, Kandinsky and his style of artwork.

Materials 1 pencil 1 box of crayons or washable markers 1 sheet 9 x 12 piece of construction paper

Introduction

# Steps

- 1. Using a pencil have your child draw the following items spaced out evenly on the paper;
- 2. A circle
- 3. Three dots
- 4. One straight line from edge to edge
- 5. One squiggly line
- 6. Next have your child trace over each item in black crayon.
- 7. Then using crayons have your child color in each portion of the shapes with a new color.
- 8. This art piece is finished when all areas of the paper have been shaded in.
- 9. Have fun with this project and remember there are no mistakes in art.

## Extension

There are many other books by Peter Reynolds you may enjoy reading to your child.
