Lesson-Line Art

The purpose of this lesson to teach students about the artist, Kandinsky and his style of artwork.

Materials

- 1 pencil
- 1 box of crayons or washable markers
- 1 sheet 9 x 12 piece of construction paper

Introduction

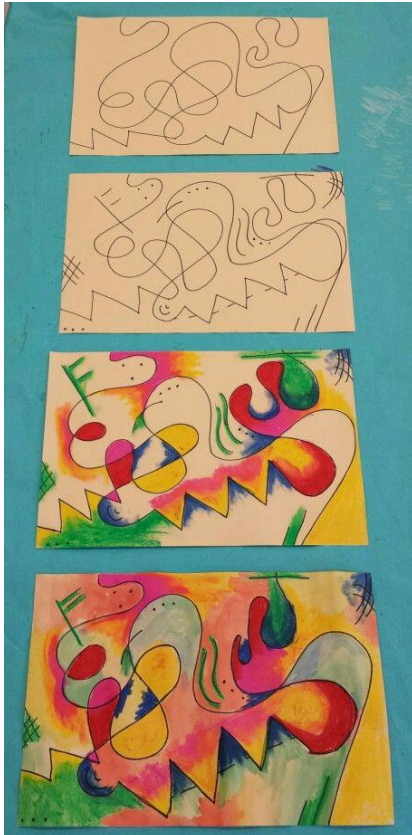
For this lesson students will first listen to a read aloud of the book, *The Dot*, by Peter Reynolds. If you have a copy, you may follow along in your book. Here is the link

Composition 8, by Kandinsky 1923

Steps

1. Using a pencil have your child draw the following items spaced out evenly on the paper;
2. A circle
3. Three dots
4. One straight line from edge to edge
5. One squiggly line
6. Next have your child trace over each item in black crayon.
7. Then using crayons have your child color in each portion of the shapes with a new color.
8. This art piece is finished when all areas of the paper have been shaded in.
9. Have fun with this project and remember there are no mistakes in art.

Extension

There are many other books by Peter Reynolds you may enjoy reading to your child.
