# Class-Artists in Action Grades 3-5 Lesson- Feather Art Teacher-Kaleen Chatigny


The purpose of this lesson is to have students learn to draw and watercolor feathers.

Materials needed
1 pencil
1 black crayon or black sharpie
Set of watercolors
9 x 12 white construction paper

### Steps

- 1. First you will sketch a single feather on your paper.
- 2. Next make sure to add details to the feather edges, it may be helpful to look at real feathers if you happen to have any at your house.
- 3. Trace over your feather, including details with your black sharpie.
- 4. Then watercolor your feather.
- 5. Repeat this activity several times, on different sheets of paper.
- 6. Once you have two or three single feathers let them dry.

#### Extensions

Feel free to cut out your feathers once they dry and then glue your collection on another piece of paper or string them across yarn.
