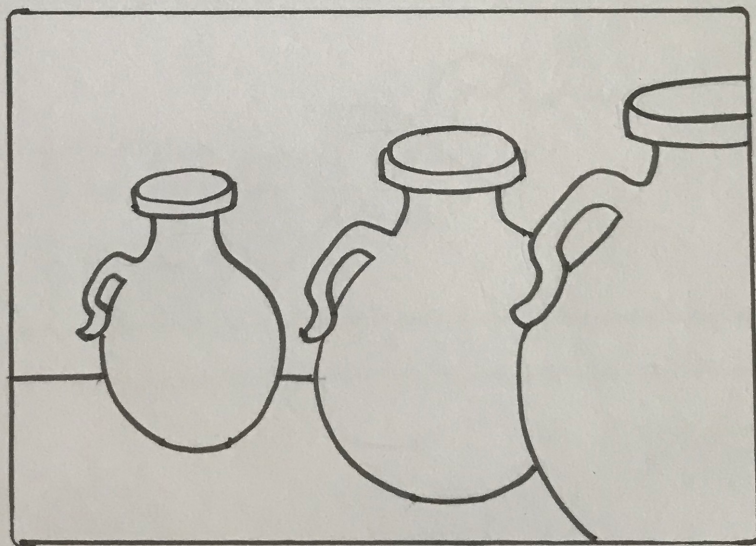
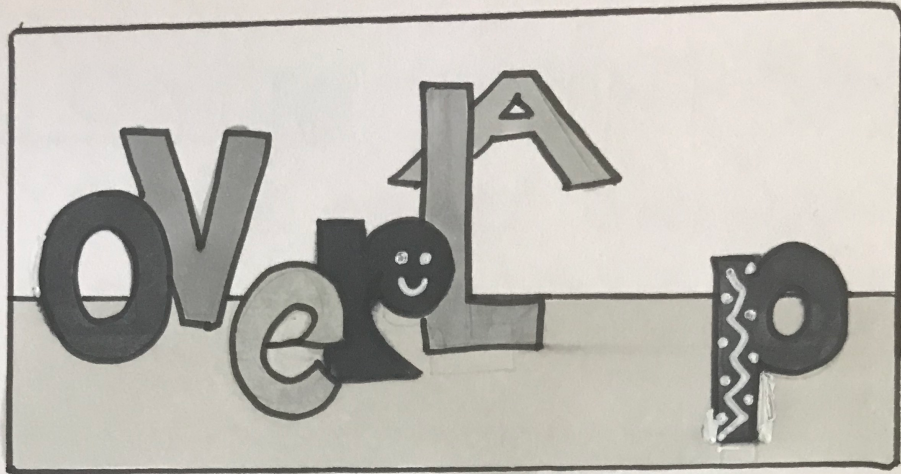


STILL LIFE

Three important parts to
drawing a still life ►



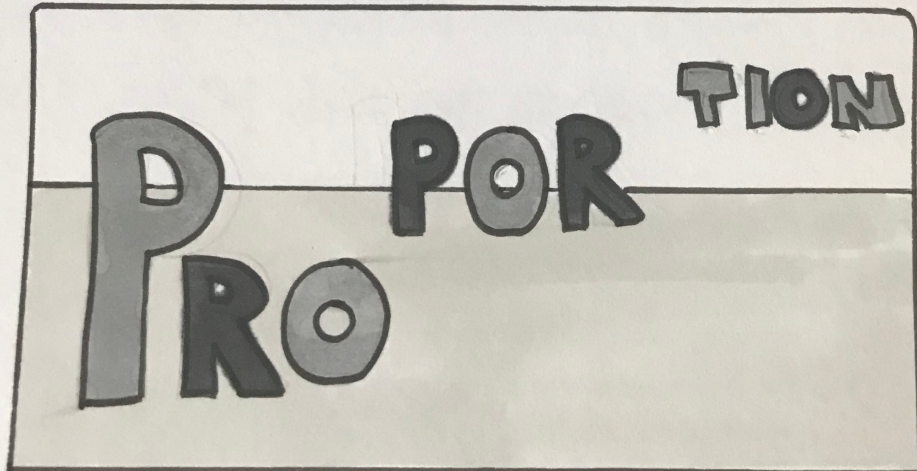

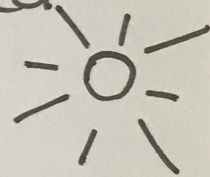
1. Overlap - objects closer to the viewer overlap objects that are behind

2. Hierarchy - objects closer to the viewer are lower on the paper.

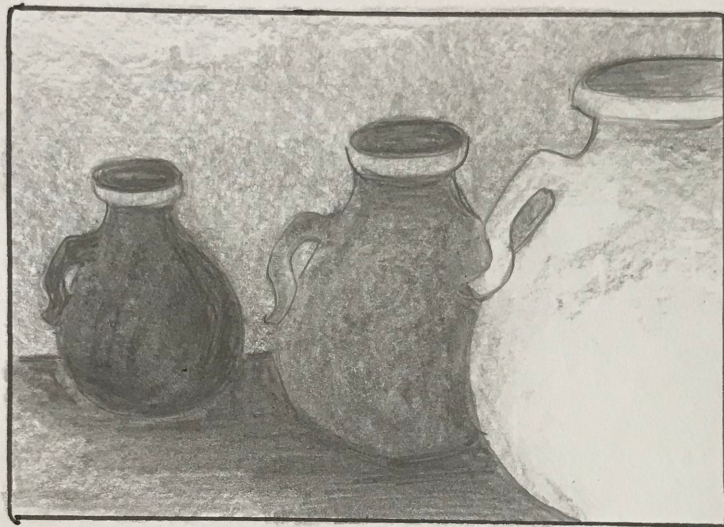
3. Proportion - really observe the objects and make sure they are in proportion to each other.

Set Up and Draw a Still Life

- Choose three objects.
- Set them up so that you have some overlap and hierarchy.
- Determine Light Source
- Draw your cluster of three objects.
- Take your time... relax!
- Don't worry about perfection

Some ideas:

- go over your lines with sharpie and erase the pencil lines.
