Class-Artists in Action Grade-Kindergarten Lesson-Tree Art Teacher-Kaleen Chatigny

The purpose of this lesson to teach students how paint an autumn tree.

Materials 1 pencil 1 black crayon 1 box of crayons Watercolor paints or finger-paints 1 9 x 12 sheet of construction paper

Introduction For this lesson students will first listen to a read aloud of the book *Sky Color*, Peter Reynolds. If you have a copy, you may follow along in your book. Here is the link <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ehfb86HoEzA</u>

Steps

- 1. First help your child trace their hand and arm half-way to the elbow. Trace this in the middle of the paper.
- 2. Next help your child to outline their arm in black crayon. The arm will become the trunk of the tree.
- 3. Then have your child shade in the tree trunk with a brown crayon or paint.
- 4. Last using either finger-paints or watercolors your child will fill in the tree with thumbprint leaves using the green, red, yellow and orange. You can also have your child paint the background with a blue sky and the ground covered in green grass.
- 5. Remember there are no mistakes in art!
