The people in your family might be more interesting than you think! Pick someone in your family to interview. Decide where the interview should take place. Consider lighting and noise when you are deciding where you will film. Maybe you can find someone else in your family to film while you do the interview. Another approach would be to do the interview while holding the camera- more of a vlogging style. No matter how you choose to do it, make sure you have a good set of questions to start with. Be ready to ask follow-up questions and don't be afraid to go off script. Remember, the more interesting the question the more interesting the answer. Make sure to avoid questions that can be answered with a yes or no answer; those tend to go nowhere interesting. When you are done filming make sure to edit your footage!
