Lesson Overview: In this lesson, your student will examine a classic folktale that they may be familiar with: *The Little Red Hen*. In the attached lesson, your student will:

- 1. Discuss background information of *The Little Red Hen*. Talk about whether your student has ever read a version of this story. What can they recall about the tale?
