Speech and Debate Lesson Plans for 5th – 8th grades

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Lesson Three: Rebuttals

In this lesson we will add the next essential skills for successful debate: Anticipating responses/ rebuttals to your argument (statement), AND Preparing your own rebuttals for these anticipated responses.

Step One: Choose a topic for your thesis statement.

- Even though you don't actually agree with your topic, your goal is present the argument as though it is fact, and attempt to get your audience to agree with you.
- Remember, when presenting a debate your goal is to prove a point through well explained, researched ideas, presented respectfully

Ideas for thesis statement: (or you can always choose your own idea)

- A) Spiders make the best pizza toppings
- B) It is best to wear roller blades while swimming
- C) Pillows full of rocks will give you a good nights sleep

Step Two:

Research your topic and come up with <u>3 reasons</u> that help to prove your point.

3 reasons for Example Idea A)

- 1. Spiders are an excellent source of protein
- 2. The legs provide a nice crunchy texture
- 3. It's a good way to reduce the amount of spider webs in your home: by eating the spiders

Step Three:

Try to anticipate REBUTTALS (counter arguments) that your opponent may present.

3 possible rebuttals for Example Idea A)

- 1. Spiders may be a good source of protein but since they are small you must eat a large quantity of them to meet your nutritional needs.
- 2. Crunchy legs may get stuck between your teeth
- 3. Spiderwebs are great for reducing the amount of gnats and flys in the home.

STEP FOUR:

Prepare your own responses to the rebuttals you have anticipated.

STEP FIVE:

Write out your debate plan to ensure you are prepared.

Use the format in the attached document "Debate worksheet"

You can hand write your own or print out the worksheet I have provided. For now, DO NOT, fill out the conclusion part of the worksheet. We will do that in lesson four.

That's all for lesson three. Lesson three is a lot of work in the preparedness process. Take your time and formulate intelligent, well researched, ideas and rebuttals. HAVE FUN!
