Exclusion of Alcohol Policy

Rationale

Forest Charter School believes that in addition to providing strong educational opportunities, the school must also act as a role model for its students in areas of conduct. Demonstrating through our actions that there is a need (or a perceived need) for alcohol during an event sends a distinct message to students. Further, drug and alcohol abuse is a problem that persists among adults as well as those who are under the legal drinking age, and FCS wishes to provide a strong example in the arena of drug and alcohol prevention. In addition to the reasons around supporting the students, FCS must also consider the potential liability issues that can arise from an event that serves alcohol. In working toward setting a strong example to the students in Forest Charter School, FCS has adopted the following policy:

Policy

Forest Charter School will not serve, buy, or provide alcohol for any events.
